

We remain very grateful for the opportunity to work closely with our Roosevelt Park neighbors and are pleased to announce that we will be working with our team this fall to host an event to further our connection with neighborhood stakeholders to help identify additional opportunities for involvement.

The Grand River Workforce Collaborative, City of Grand Rapids, Heritage Development Partners, and Wolverine Building Group are working to plan an event to be held at 4pm on October 10, 2024 at Roberto Clemente (Rumsey) Park. 
